

TERMS FOR THE 2024 FIBER DEPLOYMENT COST SURVEY PROMOTIONAL OFFER

1. Purchase Requirement: No purchase necessary.

2. Eligibility: This promotion is offered and open only to those who have been invited to participate in the survey and have completed the survey in its entirety with at least one submission by the deadline listed in Section 4. Only accurate and valid completed survey responses will be considered eligible for promotion. Cartesian may reach out if needed to confirm validity of responses.

To participate via a phone interview, you must complete a virtual interview with Fiber Broadband Association's research partner Cartesian in its entirety by appropriately answering all applicable questions asked by the researcher.

6. Limitations on Entry: Each survey submission will be treated as one entry, limit one submission per respondent to be considered for promotional entry. There is no limit on the number of submissions a respondent can provide for the survey itself.

7. Limitations on Winners: A \$100 Amazon gift card will be awarded via email to each of the first 50 respondents. Gift cards will be sent to the business email provided in the survey. Gift cards only valid on Amazon.com and not on any country-specific or secondary Amazon site. Prizes are not transferable.
